

Alphabet Ball Toss Activity

Suggested Levels: K-2

Time: 10- 20 minutes

Objective: Promotes letter identification and hand-eye coordination

Equipment: Alphabet Ball (**BUDGET FRIENDLY IDEA**- Use a regular ball and randomly write letter on white board for each toss)

Preparation: None

Description: Have students stand in a circle. Begin by tossing the ball to a student. The student must say aloud the letter that their right thumb landed on while catching. For older students, have them then name a word that begins with that letter. For an added challenge, assign a word category (ex. animals or food).
